SnapLock Industries, the parent of SnapSports, is committed to sustainability, recycling and the overall reduction of waste.

68% of our manufacturing presses are state-of-the-art, ultra-efficient electric models which use 33% less energy, 90% less hydraulic fluid, and produce 50% less heat than existing machines. We plan to have 100% electric presses by 2026. We worked with Rocky Mountain Power, our local power company to pioneer a rebate program to speed the conversion to the ultra-efficient presses. This program has been expanded to many other manufacturers and has helped reduce the overall power production needs of RMP.

All our products are made from polypropylene and are 100% recyclable. A significant number of our products are made from recycled polypropylene. All of the "waste" polypropylene that we generate is recycled and reused. We also purchase and use post-industrial and post-consumer polypropylene for these products. When we're replacing any end-of-life courts, whether ours or our competitors, we ship them back to our manufacturing facility for recycling.

We recycle 100% of the following in our manufacturing processes:

- Hydraulic oil
- Polyethylene film (stretch wrapping)
- · Cardboard/chipboard
- Wooden pallets
- Paper products

Our manufacturing process uses a closed loop cooling system to eliminate water loss.



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
